

HOW MUCH MIXED PAPER DID YOU RECYCLE TODAY?



If it tears and it's paper it can be recycled at the curb and at recycling dropoff sites.

Mixed paper includes junk mail, envelopes (plastic windows OK), packing paper, office and school paper, photocopies, file folders, brochures, receipts, lottery tickets, paperback books, detergent boxes, shoe boxes, tissue boxes, cereal boxes, dry and frozen food boxes, gable top milk and juice cartons, 6/12/24 pack beverage cartons, wrapping paper (no foil), greeting cards, postcards, post-it notes, paper sacks, paper egg cartons, wrapping paper tubes, paper towel tubes, toilet paper tubes and maps.

Shredded paper and other small bits of paper should be placed in a paper bag to keep from blowing. Recycle corrugated cardboard separately.
